**DETAILS:**

On Thursday, January 19, 2017, at about 5:00 AM, a Brown Deer Officer attempted to initiate a traffic stop of a vehicle in the 7900 block of N Sherman Blvd. The vehicle fled southbound and proceeded through the intersection at W Good Hope Rd disregarding the red traffic light. Upon entering the intersection, the vehicle was struck by a semi-truck that was traveling westbound on W Good Hope Rd causing the semi-truck to roll over onto its side. The fleeing vehicle was determined to be stolen out of the City of Milwaukee. The operator of the stolen vehicle, a seventeen-year-old Milwaukee man, died from injuries as a result of the crash. His identification is not being released at this time. The driver of the semi-truck was transported to an area hospital with what appeared to be non-life threatening injuries. The Milwaukee County Investigative Team is leading the investigation with the assistance of the Wisconsin State Patrol.
