

## Community Development Department

Community Development Director, Attorney and Manager met with two entities interested in the American TV property. One user would repurpose the former American TV building for use as a light manufacturing/warehouse facility, and the other user would be a retailer operating on an approximate 2 acre out lot. Due to this interest and the viability of the two users, the Village moved to exercise their option to purchase the site from John Schlueter of Frontline Commercial Real Estate.

## Department of Public Works

**GENERAL:** Bids were opened for the N. 60th Street water main relay and sanitary sewer lateral replacement project at 10:00am on Thursday, February 26th. The apparent low bidder for the project is MJ Construction, Inc. out of Milwaukee. The Finance & Public Works Committee recommended to the Board approval of the construction contract. The project is expected to start in early to mid-April with a substantial completion date of mid-June ahead of the roadway reconstruction project which is under a separate contract through the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT).

**STORMWATER:** The Stormwater Technician along with the help of one (1) Laborer/Driver worked on clearing snow accumulation from storm sewer catch basins and inlet covers to prevent clogging and flooding conditions ahead of the forecasted warmer temperatures. Crews worked on clearing about 500-total storm drains throughout the curb & gutter areas in the Village.

**BEAUTIFICATION/FORESTRY:** DPW crews continue trimming trees (when time permits and when not performing winter operations) along the north and south side of W. Bradley Rd between N. 51st St and N. Sherman Blvd. Next, crews will move into the Meadowside subdivision north of W. Dean Rd to complete the canopy "raising".

The Administrative Assistant started planning events for the spring Arbor Day event. Along with the Arbor Day celebration an electronic recycling and appliance recycling drive is planned.
