DETAILS:

On Wednesday, November 25, 2015, at approximately 8:50 AM, a call was received reporting a grenade had been found inside of a residence and it had been moved outside. Brown Deer Police Officers responded and as a safety precaution, secured the area. With information obtained from the person who located the grenade, a decision was made to have the Milwaukee County Bomb Squad respond. After further examination by the Bomb Squad, they were able to determine the grenade had previously been fired and was no longer a threat.

Brown Deer Police urge all residents to exercise common sense. Please leave explosives or military ordinance undisturbed and call the police immediately.
