DETAILS:

On Wednesday, May 10, 2016, at about 9:30 AM, Brown Deer Police Officers responded to an attempted car-jacking that occurred in the parking lot of Walmart, 6300 West Brown Deer Road. A 69-year-old woman was in her vehicle stopped at a red traffic signal and was approached by two subjects who attempted to enter her vehicle and demanded the victim to exit her vehicle. The victim was able to escape by driving away without injury or damage to her vehicle.

The suspects were described as two teenage black males who fled westbound on W. Brown Deer Rd. in a silver vehicle. Brown Deer Officers located the suspects and the vehicle in the 7600 block of W. Brown Deer Rd. The silver vehicle was reported as stolen out of Milwaukee. Two suspects were arrested, a 15 year old and a 17 year old, both from Milwaukee. Charges will be referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office for Attempted Robbery-Car Jacking and Operating a Motor Vehicle Without the Owner's Consent.
