**DETAILS:**

On Friday, July 1, 2016, at 1:15 P.M., Brown Deer Police Officers responded to a report of a Hit and Run which occurred in the 8200 block of North 60<sup>th</sup> Street. The victim's vehicle was struck from behind by the suspect's vehicle, the suspect vehicle fled the scene northbound on North 60<sup>th</sup> Street. The suspect vehicle was located by Brown Deer Police Officers in the 6400 block of West Brown Deer Road where it fled from Brown Deer police squads westbound on West Brown Deer Road. The driver of the suspect vehicle attempted to elude police officers by driving through the service drive of the former Northridge Mall property striking several curbs and medians in the process. The vehicle continued westbound on West Brown Deer Road and became disabled in the 10500 block of West Brown Deer Road. Two of the three occupants fled the vehicle. One subject was taken into custody on the south side of Brown Deer Road after he was located hiding in thick brush.

Milwaukee Police Department and Glendale Police K9 were requested for the second subject who fled north into a wood line. The Glendale Police K9 tracked the suspect until he could be heard yelling for help from the Little Menomonee River. The Milwaukee Fire Department was requested to respond as the suspect was yelling that he was in the water and could not swim. The subject was located and taken into custody.

The third subject was arrested from within the vehicle.

No one was injured during this incident. All three subjects taken into custody are juveniles.
