DETAILS:

On Wednesday, November 15, 2017, at about 12:07 A.M., Brown Deer Police Officers, the North Shore Fire Department, and Officers from other North Shore Police Departments responded to a report of a single car rollover accident on North Sherman Boulevard at North Teutonia Avenue. Northbound and Southbound traffic were diverted for a short time.

Upon arrival, it was determined that a 31-year-old Milwaukee man lost control of his vehicle while traveling northbound on North Sherman Boulevard. The vehicle struck several poles and signs prior to leaving the roadway and rolling over, coming to rest on its roof in a nearby field. The driver was transported to an area hospital with serious injuries. One other occupant of the vehicle fled on foot southbound on North Teutonia Avenue, but has not been located. It is unknown if this occupant sustained any injuries. He was described as a black male, about 5'08, 165 pounds, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt and gray t-shirt.

The Wisconsin State Patrol and Brown Deer Police Department are continuing with the investigation. Anyone with information on the crash or the occupant is asked to contact the Brown Deer Police Department.
