DETAILS:

Today, at about 2:35 PM, Brown Deer Police Officers were dispatched to TJ Maxx, 9020 North Green Bay Road, for the report of an attempted theft of motor vehicle from the lot. The caller stated the suspects fled in a gold Sebring towards Brown Deer Road. Officers located the suspect vehicle and attempted to stop it in the 5200 block of West Brown Deer Road, but the vehicle failed to stop. Officers pursued the vehicle into Mequon and terminated the pursuit after two squads were damaged from the suspect's vehicle. Mequon officers located the vehicle a short time later, which was determined to be stolen from Milwaukee. Officers from Ozaukee County Sheriff, Cedarburg, Thiensville and the State Patrol assisted in locating the suspects. All five suspects, ranging from 16-18 years old, were located and taken into custody. Mequon Police Department is pursuing charges in Ozaukee County. Two suspects were transported to area hospitals with non-life threatening injuries. This incident remains under investigation, therefore squad videos are currently unavailable.
