**DETAILS:**

On June 1, 2017 at about 11:38 PM, a Brown Deer Police Officer attempted to stop a vehicle for making an unsafe lane deviation and an illegal U-turn in the 4800 block of West Brown Deer Road. When the officer activated his squad's emergency lights, the vehicle accelerated to a high rate of speed. The officer slowed and did not continue to pursue the vehicle. The vehicle continued at a high rate of speed, lost control, left the roadway, rolled several times and came to a rest in the 6700 block of West Brown Deer Road. The driver was located next to a creek in the 6800 block of West Brown Deer Road after attempting to flee on foot. The 16-year-old male driver and resident of Milwaukee sustained serious injuries from the crash and was transported to a local hospital. The vehicle was later confirmed stolen from a dealership in Milwaukee. The incident remains under investigation.
