


DPW crews are assisting with preparations for the Deer Run event this weekend: Saturday, April 25th.

- The Community Development Director met with the new Outreach Coordinator from Alexian Village to discuss possible collaboration and sponsorship opportunities for events in Brown Deer during the summer including Eat and Greet, Community Vibes and the 4th of July celebration.
- The Community Development Director worked with Key Engineering on a new certified survey map to divide the former American TV lot. The land division will create separate parcels for two new users to on the property along with a regional stormwater and flood water control area. The users will be a retail operation on the southern end of the site and a light manufacturer/warehouse operation in the former American TV building.
- The Planning and Zoning Specialist attended the American Planning Association national conference in Seattle where he participated in continuing education courses sessions ranging from zoning for mixed use development to foreclosure mitigation and infrastructure planning for walkable communities.


