

NORTH SHORE HEALTH DEPARTMENT

Health Dept. leaders convened a group of leaders from NS Police Depts. & NS Fire/Rescue to discuss the rise in poisoning-related fatalities. A new report was released by the WI Dept. of Health Services discussing the rise in drug overdose deaths. Agencies discussed putting together a toolkit for residents on prevention, treatment resources for prescription drug/heroin addiction.

The 8th annual Fall Prevention Awareness Day is being observed WI and across the United States. Falls are the leading cause of fatal and nonfatal injuries for older adults in the North Shore. Falls result in hip fractures, broken bones, & head injuries. Common factors that lead to a fall are balance, gait issues, vision problems, medications, environment, chronic conditions like diabetes, stroke or arthritis. If you have an aging neighbor, parent, or grandparent, and are concerned about their fall risk, please encourage them to contact their health care provider for a falls risk assessment.
