

## NORTH SHORE HEALTH DEPARTMENT

**(There are no clinics scheduled for this week)**

Last week the North Shore Health Department leaders received further **public health emergency preparedness training** by completing Incident Command System 300 (ICS300). This training program focuses on providing skills and resources for personnel who will serve as leaders during emergency situations.

Health Department staff attended the **City of Milwaukee's 2015 Immunization Symposium**. This purpose of the symposium is to provide health care and public health professionals with the latest childhood, adolescent, and adult immunization recommendations. The focus on this year's symposium was on using the human papillomavirus vaccine to reduce the risk of contracting certain reproductive cancers in both females and males.
