NORTH SHORE HEALTH DEPARTMENT



Health department staff was very busy providing flu immunizations for North Shore residents. The CDC issued a report in September stating that currently circulating influenza viruses are similar to this year's influenza vaccine, which is a strong indication that this year's vaccine will be more effective than last year's. The Health Dept. offers the quadrivalent flu shot and the quadrivalent nasal spray vaccine. A Quadrivalent flu vaccine protects from two (2) influenza A viruses and two (2) influenza B viruses.

Weekly Health Tips

National Teen Driver Safety Week

Motor vehicle crashes are the leading cause of death among youth (5-17 yrs. old) in Wisconsin. Fortunately, we have seen a significant increase in the percent of WI high school students who report wearing a seatbelt over the past decade.

In 2013, 8% of high school students say that they never or rarely wear a seatbelt compared to 29 % in 1993. Unfortunately, a significant percent of high school students continue to report drinking & driving (9%) and texting & driving (48%).

One of the big success stories for reducing teen crash fatalities is the graduated driver licensing program (GDL)
