NORTH SHORE HEALTH DEPARTMENT

The Health Insurance Marketplace is the federally operated insurance marketplace where individuals and small businesses can sign up for health coverage. If you currently have health insurance through an employer, Medicare, or Medicaid, you don't need to do anything with the Marketplace. If you are, however, uninsured or purchase individual coverage that is inadequate or unaffordable, you should go to www.healthcare.gov to learn more about available health insurance plans. As part of the Affordable Care Act (ACA) people are required to have health insurance or pay a federal tax penalty. In 2016, the penalty for not having health insurance increases to the greater of \$695 per adult or 2.5% of taxable income. **Open enrollment for the Health Insurance Marketplace runs until January 31, 2016.**
