



“IMPORTANT NOTICE FROM CDC”

The Florida Department of Health (FL DOH) has identified an area with local mosquito-borne active Zika virus transmission in Miami (www.cdc.gov/zika/intheus/florida-update.html). Based on the earliest time of symptom onset and a maximal two-week incubation period for Zika virus, *this guidance applies to women of reproductive age and their partners who live in or traveled to this area after June 15, 2016*. Pregnant women should avoid non-essential travel to the area with active Zika virus transmission identified by the FL DOH.

There is no evidence of locally-acquired Zika or the mosquitoes that can transmit Zika in WI.

The North Shore Health Department continues to do surveillance for the *Aedes* species of mosquitoes known to transmit Zika.

Did You Know?

The first week of August (1st-7th) is **World Breastfeeding Week (WBW)**. It begins National Breastfeeding Month, which concludes with Black Breastfeeding week (August 25th-31st). WBW has been observed since 1992 and is now celebrated in over 170 countries. This year's theme, **Breastfeeding: A Key to Sustainable Development**, celebrates links between breastfeeding and the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals, which are a blueprint for global commitment and action towards equitable development.

The North Shore Health Department launched its **Breastfeeding Friendly Workplace Recognition Program**, in honor of World Breastfeeding Week. If you are a North Shore business, or work for one, please consider contacting us about becoming recognized as a breastfeeding friendly workplace. 

End-of-Season Dog Swim

Brown Deer Pond is going to the dogs!

Mon. August 22nd from 4:00-7:00pm

Sat. August 27th from 11:00am-2:00pm

The Pond is fully enclosed and the perfect spot for your beloved pooch to play, run and swim

The following guidelines must be followed:

- Dogs must be on a leash when entering the Pond.
- Only dogs with an adult or youth age 12 and older may enter the Pond.
 - Individuals may wade waist-deep in Pond water.
 - Balls and soft-thrown toys are allowed. No sticks!
- Individuals must bring a bag and pick up their dog's waste.
 - Only well-socialized and friendly dogs will be allowed.

In addition, donations will be collected for the Wisconsin Humane Society
