DETAILS:

On Friday, 12-15-17 at approximately 9:00 p.m. officers responded to the report of a residential burglary in the 6500blk of W Floral Ln. The victim/homeowner advised the suspect(s) may still be inside of her residence. Upon arrival, the responding officers observed fresh footprints in the snow leading from the victim's home. Officers followed the footprints to the 6500blk of W Donges Ln where they observed a white Cadillac sedan stuck in the ditch. When officers attempted to make contact with the male subject inside of the vehicle he fled on foot into a tree line where he attempted to hide.

Officers pursued the suspect into the tree line where he failed to comply with orders and physically struggled with the officers attempting to arrest him. Once in custody numerous items that had been taken during burglary were located both in the suspect's vehicle and in the tree line where he hid from officers.

On 12-19-17, the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office charged Vonderrick L Rayford, 43 years-old, from the City of Milwaukee, with Burglary (Building or Dwelling) and Habitual Criminality Repeater ([2017CF005790](#))
