### DETAILS:

**On Wednesday, March 7, 2018, at about 3:53 A.M., the Mequon Police Department advised that a vehicle fled from them southbound on North Cedarburg Road. Brown Deer Officers located the vehicle in the 3700 block of West Bradley Road and attempted to initial a traffic stop on the vehicle. The driver fled from officers southbound on North Green Bay Road. As the driver was fleeing, he was seen throwing a clear, plastic baggie out of the passenger window. A pursuit was initiated.**

**The driver stopped his vehicle in a parking lot in the 7100 block of North Teutonia Avenue and was taken into custody. The male driver was booked for knowingly fleeing from officers and possession of a controlled substance-THC. He was transported to the Milwaukee County Jail. Charges will be referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office.**
