Parking is available for senior citizens and disabled individuals in the FIS Parking Lot across the street from Village Park. Permits are required. Please obtain a parking permit and instructions at the Village Hall the week of June 11.

Patrons attending the 4th of July Parade and bringing pets are asked to please control their animals. Uncontrolled animals could present a danger to other patrons and animals in the parade. Village Ordinance 6-1.03 requires pets to be under the immediate control of the owner and on a leash.

Patrons and participants are advised not to use water guns or soakers at the parade staging area or parade route.

Chapter VIII, Volume I of the Brown Deer Village Code prohibits dogs and bicycles in the Village Park. The Code also prohibits the use of portable grills, skateboards, fris-bees, jarts or other athletic equipment that can be thrown or tossed in the Village Park on July 4.
