

2018 Water System Flushing

The annual **Big Flush** of the water system will start **Tuesday, May 22nd** and last approximately 6-8 weeks. Flushing will cause a temporary stirring of sediments in the water system. Some suggestions to make the *Big Flush* go smoothly:

- ◆ Watch for the signs! We will post signs along the entry roads to the neighborhood being flushed on any given day.
- ◆ The day we are in your neighborhood, refrain from doing the laundry if possible (sediment can damage clothes & washing machines) & wait for the water to clear before using it for drinking or cooking.
- ◆ The days following the flush are a good time for you to *spring clean* your plumbing. Run water from all faucets for about 5 minutes while flushing all toilets. While this seems like a lot of water, it is a good practice to remove any loose sediment buildup in your own plumbing. The cost of a 5-minute flush is less than 15 cents.
- ◆ After flushing your plumbing, remove faucet screens and clean out any sediment that collects.
