- ____ 1) Sales shall be conducted between the following hours on the designated dates:

- ____ 2) All outdoor temporary electrical systems shall comply with the National Electrical Code and shall be inspected and approved by the Village Electrical Inspector prior to opening sales areas to the public.

- ____ 3) The area proposed for the sale shall not occupy any of the parking lot normally used as vehicle lanes. In particular, fire lanes shall be kept clear of sales merchandise and parked vehicles.

- ____ 4) The above applicant will take whatever steps are necessary in the opinion of the Building Inspector to prevent the accumulation of debris and litter resulting from the sale.

- ____ 5) All signs shall comply with Chapter 121, Article IX of the Brown Deer Village Code. No flags or flashing lights shall be permitted. One special event banner is allowed with issuance of a permit from the Building Inspector.

- ____ 6) All sales of food for consumption on the premises shall be conducted in conformance with the regulations of the Brown Deer Health Department.

- ____ 7) No refrigerated trucks used for the sale shall be permitted to run between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M. the following day.

- ____ 8) The use and erection of tents shall conform with the Wisconsin Administrative Code ILHR 62.42 through 62.51, and shall provide for required exits and fire extinguishers as determined by applicable code.

- ____ 9) All sales shall be conducted on private property. No sales activities shall occur within the right-of-way of any public streets or public service drives.
