In response to the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) outbreak and the declaration of a public health emergency by the Governor of the State of Wisconsin, the Brown Deer Police Department is taking steps to help reduce the spread of the virus and protect the health and safety of our residents and staff. As a result, we will be temporarily reducing some of our services. The following is a list of changes to our services along with some alternatives. This list may be modified when needed:

- Police Department tours, public speaking events and citizen ride-alongs have been suspended.
- Fingerprinting services (employment, applications, etc.) have been suspended.
- Officer review of Vehicle Equipment Correction Notices for other agencies have been suspended.
- Preliminary Breath Testing (PBT) services have been suspended.
- Prescription Drug Box drop off collection is suspended.
- The Police Department lobby remains accessible; however, people are encouraged to stay out of the building unless there is an urgent or emergent need to come inside. The non-emergency telephone number for the Police Department is 414-371-2900.
- Brown Deer Municipal Court has closed until May 1, 2020. Trials that were scheduled during the closure will be rescheduled.
