

VILLAGE HALL CLOSURE

Effective immediately, the Brown Deer Village Hall is closed to the public. Staff will be available to answer email messages and telephone calls.

The Wisconsin Election Commission governs the elections process. The Presidential Preference Primary/Spring Election is scheduled for Tuesday, April 7, 2020. Nevertheless, you have options to avoid contact with others.

With the Coronavirus pandemic in mind, the Village of Brown Deer is strongly urging residents to consider requesting an Absentee Ballot to minimize person-to-person contact.

In-person early absentee voting has been suspended at Village Hall. If you need to register or change your address, please call 414.371.3050 to make an appointment with the Village Clerk.

We encourage all qualified electors to request an absentee ballot to be received by mail.

The polling sites will be open on Election Day, to vote in-person, but it is **highly recommended** you request an absentee ballot before April 2, 2020.

The fastest and easiest way to vote absentee is by going to <https://myvote.wi.gov/en-US/VoteAbsentee> to request a ballot be mailed.

As a reminder, you will need to include a picture of your photo I.D. in order to complete the request online!

Water and Tax Payments may be left at this drop box or the one located outside. You may include a self-addressed stamped envelope if you would like a receipt mailed back to you. If you opt to mail your tax payment, it must be postmarked no later than March 31, 2020.
