


## The Cowboy Who Came Calling by Linda Broday

She has no option now but to take the handsome stranger home to treat his wounds.


## The Last Good Cowboy by Kate Pearce





## To Love and to Cherish by Leigh Greenwood


## Pursued by the Rich Rancher by Catherine Mann




### **Texas Redemption by Linda Broday**


### **Whispering Pines by Scarlett Dunn**

### **The Last Outlaw by Rosanne Bittner**



### **Forever a Hero by Linda Lael Miller**






### **Here and Then by Linda Lael Miller**





### **Texas Tall by Kaki Warner**
