

Resolution Requiring Face
Covering During the
COVID-19 Pandemic

Resolution No. 20-

WHEREAS, the Village Board for the Village of Brown Deer recognizes the spread of the COVID-19 virus as a global pandemic; and,

WHEREAS, the Village Board finds it in the public’s interest to establish a policy which will be in the best interest of the public health, welfare, and safety of all Brown Deer residents and visitors; and,

WHEREAS, a Face Covering is defined as a protective mask covering the nose and mouth, including cloth face coverings or surgical masks as described by the Center of Disease Control and Prevention; and,

WHEREAS, wearing a Face Covering will contribute to avoiding or reducing the spread of infection caused by the COVID-19 virus.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this resolution will remain in effect until the Village Board of the Village of Brown Deer declare a face covering is no longer necessary. The Village Board of the Village of Brown Deer suggests that any person four years old or older who is present in the Village of Brown Deer should have a face covering when the person leaves home or other places of residence, and should wear the face covering whenever the person is in a public space in which social distancing of 6-feet or more cannot be maintained with non-family members or those living within their place of residence.

FURTHERMORE, the Village Manager is directed to establish face covering requirements for Village employees and other persons on properties or in any Village owned facilities. The foregoing resolution shall not apply to persons under four years of age, persons who fall into the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention’s guidelines for those who should not wear a face covering due to a medical condition, mental health condition, development disability, or are otherwise covered under the Americans With Disabilities Act, persons with an upper respiratory chronic condition or silent disabilities, and persons in settings where it is not practical or feasible to wear face coverings including but not limited to the following: when obtaining goods or services such as the receipt of dental services, medical treatments, or consuming food and drink.
