

PUBLIC NOTICE TO ALL CUSTOMERS OF THE BROWN DEER WATER PUBLIC UTILITY

The Brown Deer Water Public Utility has filed an application with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSCW) to increase water rates. The increase is necessary due to a 20.78 percent increase in gross plant investment and a 15.76 percent increase in operating expenses since the last water rate case was completed in 2013.

The total increase in water revenues requested is \$211,675 which will result in an estimated overall rate increase of 13.19 percent over the water utility's present revenues. If the request is granted, the water bill for an average residential customer with a 5/8-inch or 3/4-inch meter who uses 13,000 gallons of water per quarter will increase from \$50.63 to \$57.01, or 12.60%.

A person may testify in this proceeding without becoming a party and without attorney representation. A person may submit this testimony in only one of the following ways:
